FIRST GRADE STUDIES

In First Grade MATH our students will

- Fluently add and subtract within 20.
- Learn to represent a 2-digit number with tens and ones.
- Learn to tell time to the hour and half hour.
- Identify pennies and dimes.
- Distinguish 2-D and 3-D shapes by different attributes.
- Partition shapes into halves and quarters.

In First Grade READING and LANGUAGE ARTS our students will

- Participate in small group, hands-on literacy centers.
- Study spelling patterns and rules through *Wilson Fundations*®, specifically introducing digraphs, glued sounds, and common trick words.
- Utilize Accelerated Reader in the classroom and set personalized goals.
- Read and practice poetry.

In First Grade SCIENCE and HEALTH our students will

- Learn about the five senses.
- Learn about investigations & experiments.
- Learn about the life cycle of plants and butterflies through hands-on investigations.
- Learn about the properties of matter: solid, liquid, and gas.
- Discuss different forces and energy.

In First Grade SOCIAL STUDIES our students will

- Learn about things now & long ago.
- Learn about our Earth and different types of landforms.
- Understand the difference between goods and services.
- · Learn about citizenship and responsibilities.
- Read and analyze tools such as timelines, maps, globes, and artifacts.
