THIRD GRADE STUDIES

In Third Grade **MATH** our students will

- Learn to fluently multiply and divide numbers to 12.
- Begin understanding how to find the perimeter and area of a shape.
- Solve multi-step word problems that involve the four operations.
- Participate in math centers.

In Third Grade **READING** and **LANGUAGE ARTS** our students will

- Use reference material to find definitions, synonyms, and antonyms for vocabulary.
- Write informational, opinion and narrative writing.
- Participate in literacy centers.
- Read a variety of fiction and nonfiction books.
- Read together in book clubs.
- Study spelling patterns and rules through *Wilson Foundations*®.

In Third Grade **SCIENCE** and **HEALTH** our students will

- Learn about plant and animal life cycles.
- Learn about rocks and minerals.
- Learn about matter and how it changes state.
- Learn about our skeletal system.
- Be able to perform basic first aid.
- Understand how to live a healthy life.

In Third Grade **SOCIAL STUDIES** our students will
