THIRD GRADE ACADEMICS

In Third Grade RELIGION the students will

- · Learn to recite The Nicene Creed.
- Participate in a special All Saints' Day Mass dressed as a saint.
- · Learn and name the seven sacraments.
- Participate in reconciliation during Advent and Lent.

In Third Grade MATH the students will

- Learn to fluently multiply and divide numbers to 12.
- Begin understanding how to find the perimeter and area of a shape.
- Solve multi-step word problems that involve the four operations.
- Participate in math centers.

In Third Grade READING & LANGUAGE ARTS the students will

- Use reference material to find definitions, synonyms, and antonyms for vocabulary words.
- · Write informational, opinion and narrative writing.
- Participate in literacy centers.
- Read a variety of fiction and nonfiction books.
- · Read together in book clubs.
- Study spelling patterns and rules through Wilson Fundations®.

In Third Grade SCIENCE and HEALTH the students will
