WELCOME TO FOURTH GRADE

FOURTH GRADE ACADEMICS

In Fourth Grade RELIGION the students will

- Understand that the Bible is the written story of God's covenant and locate verses in Sacred Scripture.
- Identify the seven sacraments and explain how they are celebrations of God's love.
- Identify the 10 Commandments and Beatitudes and describe how they are moral guidelines for our lives.
- Identify different forms of prayer and be able to pray all 20 mysteries of the Rosary.

In Fourth Grade MATH the students will

- Use the four operations to solve multi-step problems and analyze patterns.
- Compare, order, and perform computations with fractions and decimals.
- Solve problems involving measurement and conversion of measurements.
- Learn about lines and angles, and their relationship to shapes.

In Fourth Grade READING & LANGUAGE ARTS the students will

- Complete novel projects and express their knowledge in varied formats.
- Write opinion, informative, and narrative papers and write multiple paragraph papers.
- Study spelling patterns and rules and learn word roots, prefixes, and suffixes.
- Learn speaking and presentation skills.
- · Continue to practice and refine cursive handwriting skills.

In Fourth Grade SCIENCE and HEALTH the students will

- Learn about how biotic and abiotic features interact in an ecosystem.
- Identify the processes that change the Earth's surface.
- Describe and demonstrate different ways energy can be transferred.
- Explore how family, peers, culture, technology, and mass media impact decision making.
- Distinguish between bullying behavior and other conflicts, and understand when to seek the help of an adult.
- List and describe the functions of nutrients in order to evaluate eating choices.

In Fourth Grade SOCIAL STUDIES the students will

- Learn about timelines.
- Learn about civic responsibilities.
- Learn about our state and national governments.
- · Learn about Ohio's geography, history, economy, and people.
- Learn about Ohio's location and economic role in the United States and the world.
