# WELCOME TO SIXTH GRADE

## SIXTH GRADE ACADEMICS

### In Sixth Grade **RELIGION** the students will

- Discuss the major historical figures and events in the Old Testament.
- Participate in liturgies and devotions such as Mass, prayer services, Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, and others.
- Examine aspects of morality, including free will, conscience, and stewardship.

### In Sixth Grade **MATH** the students will

- Interpret ratios and rates and convert between fractions, decimals, and percents.
- Compute with multi-digit numbers and fractions.
- Evaluate numerical and algebraic expressions.
- Explore integers, rational numbers, and the coordinate plane.
- Understand mean, median & mode, and graph statistical data.

### In Sixth Grade **READING & LANGUAGE ARTS** the students will

- Read and analyze a variety of fiction and nonfiction texts.
- Develop oral communication skills and improve English grammar.
- Advance writing skills through analytical, evidence-based writing, and produce a variety of written work using Google Docs.
- Build vocabulary skills using S.A.T. based curriculum.

### In Sixth Grade **SCIENCE** the students will

- Learn about rocks and minerals.
- Identify and define parts of animal and plant cells.
- Learn about renewable and nonrenewable energy resources.
- Participate in labs and online labs dealing with above topics.

### In Sixth Grade **HEALTH** the students will

- Study proper nutrition and fitness.
- Identify various body systems and their functions.
- Learn procedures for safety and how to treat injuries.
- Examine the consequences of inappropriate behaviors.

### In Sixth Grade **SOCIAL STUDIES** the students will

- Examine geographic features and their impact on human activity.
- Study the development and influence of the ancient cultures of Mesopotamia, India, Egypt, and China.
- Complete integrative and cross-curricular projects, including connections between the Catholic faith and Eastern cultures.
- Explore how the diffusion of agricultural practices and products, technology, and world religions (Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, and Judaism) has impacted the Eastern Hemisphere.
