WELCOME TO KINDERGARTEN

KINDERGARTEN ACADEMICS

In Kindergarten **RELIGION** the students will

- Recognize that God loves me, made me special, and gave me talents.
- Understand church celebrations.

In Kindergarten **MATH** the students will

- Recognize numbers 1-100.
- Count to 100 by 1's, 5's, and 10's.
- Make patterns, graphs, and sort objects.
- Identify 2 and 3 dimensional shapes.
- Learn addition and subtraction concepts.

In Kindergarten **LITERACY** the students will

- Recognize all capital and lowercase letters and sounds.
- Blend letter sounds to read simple words and sentences.
- Recognize and read sight words.
- Read and respond to a variety of fiction and nonfiction literature.
- Learn manuscript writing of the letters A-Z.
- Write sentences with illustrations to tell about an event.
- Begin to use the Accelerated Reader program.

In Kindergarten **SCIENCE** and **HEALTH** the students will

- Make discoveries about their environment.
- Examine animal and plant life.
- Understand how to take care of their bodies.
- Explore the five senses.

In Kindergarten **SOCIAL STUDIES** the students will

- Understand the importance of being a good citizen.
- Introduce historic figures and holiday celebrations.
- Name and sequence days of the week and months of the year.
- Learn about community helpers.
